Loon Update - Larry 4 chicks born this year, all have died with the final chick washing ashore, corpse given to Lori Naumann from the DNR. 7 adults most of the year (an unusually high amount for our small, round lake). Perhaps previous years chicks have come back to account for the 7 adults. By mid Sept, adult loons will be leaving. Eagles may be responsible for loss of some of the chicks. 4th chick had no puncture marks, but had 2 broken wings. An eagle would have taken chick to eat, so perhaps chick hit by boat or jetski.
